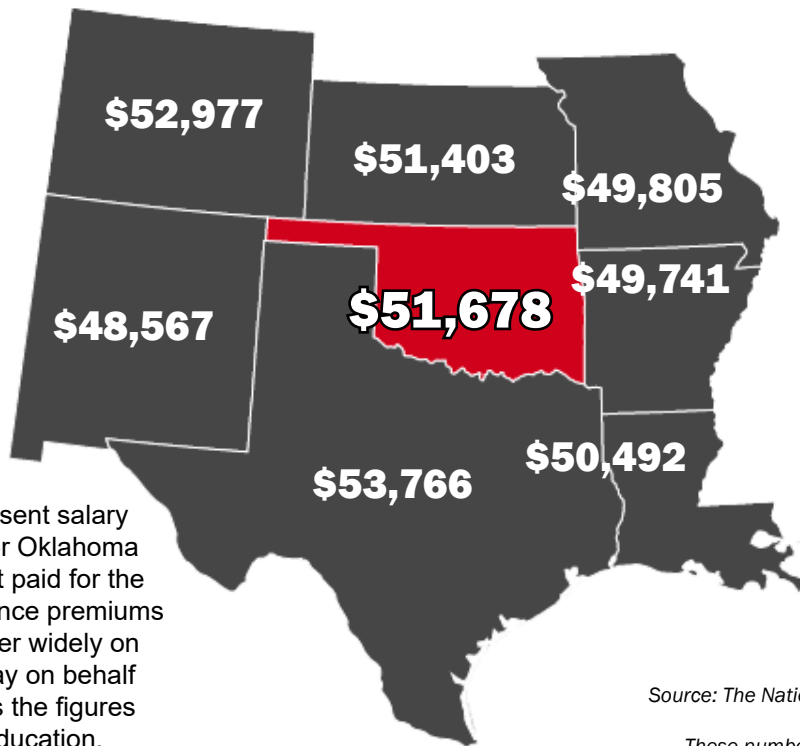


Average Teacher Salary



“Teacher” is defined for this statistic as, “A staff member assigned the professional activities of instructing pupils in self-contained classes or courses or in classroom situations. The number of classroom teachers is usually expressed in full-time equivalents.”

All figures in this chart represent salary and fringe benefits, which for Oklahoma teachers includes retirement paid for the employee and health insurance premiums paid by the state. States differ widely on what, if any, benefits they pay on behalf of teachers. NEA assembles the figures from state departments of education.
