



## Your 30-second guide to Saving Our State

### A few tips when you call your legislator:

- 1) Say your name, phone number, and address at the beginning of the call so your elected official knows they are hearing from their constituent.
- 2) Be polite, but firm.
- 3) If you mess up, just repeat your last statement and move along!

### Let's get started!

- 1) Look up the contact information of your legislator at [okhouse.gov](http://okhouse.gov) or [oksenate.gov](http://oksenate.gov)
- 2) Follow the script on the back, or feel free to personalize it if you like.
- 3) Make sure you leave your address.
- 4) Simply hang up when you are done.

## Use this sample script or personalize it!

*Hi, this is \_\_\_\_\_, and I live in your district at city, state, zip. I'm calling to ask you to take the necessary steps to Save Our State and fix our budget. I support education, public safety, good roads and access to health care – and I am calling to ask you to do the same. I understand your job is hard, but it is not impossible. I also want you to make big oil pay their fair share by raising the gross production tax. Thank you, my phone number is (\_\_\_\_)\_\_\_\_ - \_\_\_\_\_ if you have any questions. Goodbye. [Note: Leaving your phone number is optional, but many legislators prefer you do so they can follow up.]*
