THE EARLY ENROLLMENT PLEDGE

As a participant in the Oklahoma Education Association / National Education Association Early Enrollment Membership Incentive Plan, I am eligible to receive – prior to September 1, but in no event before April 1 – benefits under the NEA Educators Employment Liability (EEL) Program, select NEA Member Benefits programs and OEA's Personal Legal Services Program (PLSP).

As a condition of eligibility for these benefits, I agree to pay the appropriate unified Active membership dues for the next membership year in accordance with established payment procedures. Should I fail to do so, my eligibility to receive benefits under the NEA EEL Program and OEA PLSP Program shall immediately terminate. In addition, I shall become liable for the cost of any benefits that were provided to me under the NEA EEL Program and/or OEA PLSP Program prior to September 1.
