<sup>\*</sup>National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP). A sample of Oklahoma fourth and eighth grade students must take biennial NAEP reading and math tests but NAEP will not satisfy statewide testing requirements under Title I. States must participate in NAEP in order to allow the federal government to make cross-state comparisons of educational progress.

**College & Career Ready Assessment (CCRA) -** To meet federal and state requirements - individual districts will choose the SAT or ACT as Part 1 of the CCRA. A science content assement will be Part 2 of the CCRA to meet federal requirements.

**ELA - Writing Standards assessed through ELA assessment** - 5th & 8th grade - 2 sections multiple choice, 1 section Constructed Response Item. 3rd, 4th, 6th & 7th - assessed through multiple-choice items over grammar, usage & mechanics. 11th ACT or SAT -- writing passage.

State Test that **exceeds** Federal requirements - students assessed when enrolled in high school US History course.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Reading Sufficiency Act (RSA) - Every student in kindergarten, first, second, and third grades shall be assessed at the beginning and end of each school year for the acquisition of reading skills (phonics, phonemic awareness, vocabulary, comprehension and fluency) for the grade level in which enrolled.
