Although the OEA Fund for Children and Public Education requests a contribution of at least \$1 a month, this is only a suggestion. A member may contribute more or less than the suggested amount, or may contribute nothing at all, without it affecting his or her membership status, rights, or benefits in OEA or any of its local affiliates. Contributions or gifts to the OEA Fund for Children and Public Education are not deductible as charitable contributions for federal income tax purposes. OEA is required to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer for each individual whose contributions aggregate in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. Applicable law prohibits the OEA Fund for Children and Public Education from receiving donations from persons other than members of the OEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families. All donations from persons other than members of OEA and its affiliates, and their immediate families, will be returned forthwith.
