About This Guide

The Oklahoma Education Association Legislative Dashboard is designed to serve as a guide for members who want to better understand their lawmakers by better learning about their backgrounds, their voting records, and their roles in the Oklahoma Legislature. Here's a quick overview of key parts of the guide.

Individual Lawmaker Accessibility Scores

The OEA Legislative and Political Organizing Team gives each lawmaker an accessibility score, which reflects how willing lawmakers are to interact with OEA members and staff. New lawmakers do not receive a rating until they complete a full session.

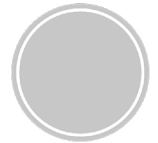

Bills for the Voting Record

These bills were chosen because of their broad-reaching consequences for public education. Some legislation was voted on in both chambers, and some was voted on by only one.



House Bill 1010xx for BOTH CHAMBERS: This budget deal funded the teacher and support professional pay raises of 2018. It increased classroom funding by \$50 million, with \$33 million earmarked for textbooks. The bill passed 79-19 in the House and 36-10 in the Senate. OEA supported this bill.



Senate Bill 1048 for BOTH CHAMBERS: The education budget bill of 2019 contained the language that mandated a certified teacher pay raise. This bill passed 89-1 in the House and 45-0 in the Senate. OEA supported this bill.



Senate Bill 9 for the SENATE: This 2019 bill aimed to remove the only standardized test still administered in Oklahoma that isn't required by the federal government. It passed 31-15 in the Senate, but it died after the House Common Education Committee declined to hear it. OEA supported this bill.



House Bill 2304 for the HOUSE: The 2019 bill started as an 8% cost-of-living adjustment for retirees receiving state pensions. The House passed the bill 98-3 after they amended it down from 8% to 4%, but then it stalled in the Senate. The Senate Retirement and Insurance Committee amended it down from 4% to 2%. Then, rather than take action on that 2%, they decided to send the bill off for study by an actuary. This was an unnecessary and cumbersome step they decided to take, and it essentially put the bill on ice for a year. So HB 2304, which is now a 2% COLA, is expected to come back up in committee — right where it left off — during the 2020 session. OEA supports this bill.



Voucher Bills in the Voting Record

Vouchers are an attack on public education, and a litany of bills were filed in the wake of the 2018 teacher walkout. Lawmakers adopted a particularly unseemly tactic in 2019: using vulnerable populations as stepping stones for voucher expansion. OEA opposed all of these bills.



Senate Bill 407 for BOTH CHAMBERS: This 2019 bill would have expanded tax credits for private school donors. It passed 27-20 in the Senate. *Note: The title was off of this bill, which means it would have come back for a final vote in the Senate. Some senators said they would have voted differently on that second vote. After the Senate vote, the bill moved to the House Appropriations & Budget Committee, where it passed 16-13. However, it was never brought to the House floor because of mounting pressure from OEA members to oppose the bill.*



Senate Bill 901 for the SENATE: This was a voucher bill for children experiencing homelessness. To help these children, lawmakers could instead invest in any number of social services or public education, which serves thousands of these students every single day. Only members of the Senate Education Committee voted on this bill.



Senate Bill 570 for the SENATE: This 2019 bill would have created a new voucher system for children who have experienced bullying. Lawmakers could invest in anti-bullying measures without expanding vouchers. Only members of the Senate Education Committee voted on this bill.



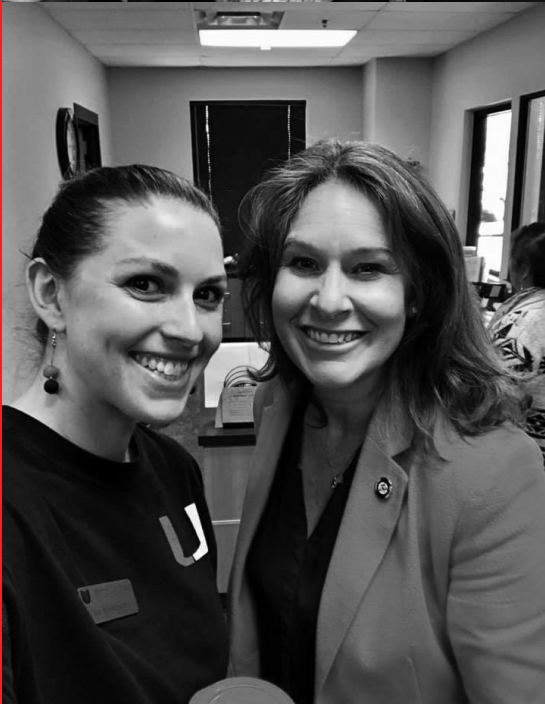
House Bill 2621 for the HOUSE: This bill would raise the cap to \$30 million for tax credit giveaways that can be used for private school scholarships. This bill was passed 19-11 by the House Appropriations and Budget Committee. The bill never went up for a vote by the full House because of intense pressure from OEA members and other education advocates. However, OEA staff members kept a whip count of how state representatives promised to vote if it came to the House floor. *Note: These voting records reflect how state representatives committed to vote to OEA members and staff. The options are committed to oppose, committed to support, and uncommitted. At the final count, 50 representatives committed to oppose HB 2621, nine representatives committed to support HB 2621, and 42 representatives were uncommitted on how they would have voted for HB 2621 had it come to a full House vote. For those 42 uncommitted representatives, 16 made a vote in committee, so their votes are included in these voting records.*

OEA Position on Vouchers and Equal Opportunity Scholarships

“The OEA believes that voucher plans, tuition tax credits, or any funding formulas under which Pre-K through 12 non-public education is subsidized by tax monies undermine public education, reduce support needed to adequately fund public education, and have the potential for racial, economic, and social segregation of children. Therefore, the Association opposes all attempts to establish and/or implement such plans.” — OEA Resolutions, IV-3

- **Feb. 3:** Session begins

- **April 23:** Deadline for a floor vote in the opposite chamber

OEA 2020 Legislative Agenda



I. Continue implementing the “Together We’re Stronger” Plan, including: increased classroom funding to offset the education budget cuts of the past ten years; a pay raise that ensures all education support professionals earn a living wage and all teachers earn a regionally competitive salary; and a Cost of Living Adjustment for retired educators.

II. Revoke the single summative letter grade from the A through F statewide accountability system.

III. Eliminate costly and ineffective mandatory U.S. History exam.

IV. Evaluate the retention provisions of the Reading Sufficiency Act.

V. Expand the health benefits of all education professionals to include dependent coverage.

VI. Protect public school funding by opposing legislation that would divert money away from public schools.

VII. Remove the salary cap for retired education professionals returning to work in a school district.

VIII. Eliminate the authority of the State Board of Education to override local school board decisions on charter school authorization.

IX. Eliminate the financial incentives provided by virtual schools for the recruitment of teachers and students and move virtual schools under the authority of the State Board of Education.

X. Monitor the rule making process related to the 4-day school week waiver.
