Oklahoma Highlights*

National Executive Summary

The national average public school teacher salary for 2021-22 was \$66, 745 and the national average one-year change in public school teacher salaries from 2020-21 to 2021-22 was 2.0 percent.

The national average per-student expenditure in 2021-22 based on fall enrollment was \$15, 368, a gain of 5.9% from \$14, 512 in 2020-21

The national number of public school classroom teachers is expected to decrease slightly by 0.3 percent from 2021-22 (3, 192, 475) to 2022-23 (3, 182, 044).

Rankings 2022

- Oklahoma has 509 operating public school districts which ranks the state 12th in number of districts.
- For Public School total fall enrollment, Oklahoma ranked 25th and 26th in 2021 and 2022, respectively. Enrollment positively changed in Oklahoma by 0.66 which ranks the state 17th in enrollment change.

- For average daily attendance, Oklahoma was ranked 25th and 26th in 2021 and 2022, respectively. ADA changed -.18 which ranks OK as 34th in change of ADA.

- Oklahoma ranks 27th in number of instructional staff in public schools. Oklahoma ranks 39th for the rate of change in instructional staff between 2021 and 2022.

National Trends 2014-23

Ten Year Trend in Total Number of Public School Districts, SY 2014-2023

- In 2014, there were 16,430 public school districts in the nation and that number remained stable. Now in 2023, we still have about the same number of districts at 16,431. 2019 saw the highest spike with 16,555 districts in the nation.

Ten Year Trend in Public School Fall Enrollment, SY 2014-2023

- The number of students enrolled in usa public schools increased from 2014- 2020 then fell 2021-2023
- The most significant degree of change from 2014 happened this year with a decrease of 1.76% in enrollment nationwide.

Ten Year Trend in Public School Average Daily Attendance, SY 2014-2023

2023: 45,822,323

- Average daily attendance remained steady or increasing from 2014-2019 then sharply fell in 2020 and stayed low in 2021, likely due to the pandemic. 2023 is estimated to once again see an increase in average daily attendance with a positive rate of change of .35%. Overall, even with

the increase in the 2023 estimate from the prior year, we will still see a negative degree of change from 2014 (-1.58% change) in daily attendance.

- The total number of teachers in the nation estimated for 2023 is .33% less than the number of teachers in 2022.
- The total number of other professionals in the nation estimated for 2023 is 3.22% higher than in 2022. The number of other professionals has increased by 28.35% since 2014. Our school capacity has clearly been growing to meet the needs of increased enrollment.
- The total number of principals and supervisors has increased by 23.22% since 2014, but 2023 will see a decrease of .54% from the prior year. There was a notable increase in principals and supervisors in 2019 which was 6.17% higher than 2019.
- The total number of all instructional staff has steadily increased since 2014. The 2023 estimate is 5.20% higher than the 2014 actual number.

- 2021 saw the biggest jump nationwide for per student expenditures with a 5.96% increase from the prior year
- 2018 saw the smaller increase nationwide for per student expenditures with a 3.04% increase from the prior year.

- 2021 saw the biggest jump nationwide for expenditures per student ADA with a 6.76% increase from the prior year
- 2018 saw the smallest increase nationwide with a 3.21% increase from the prior year.
