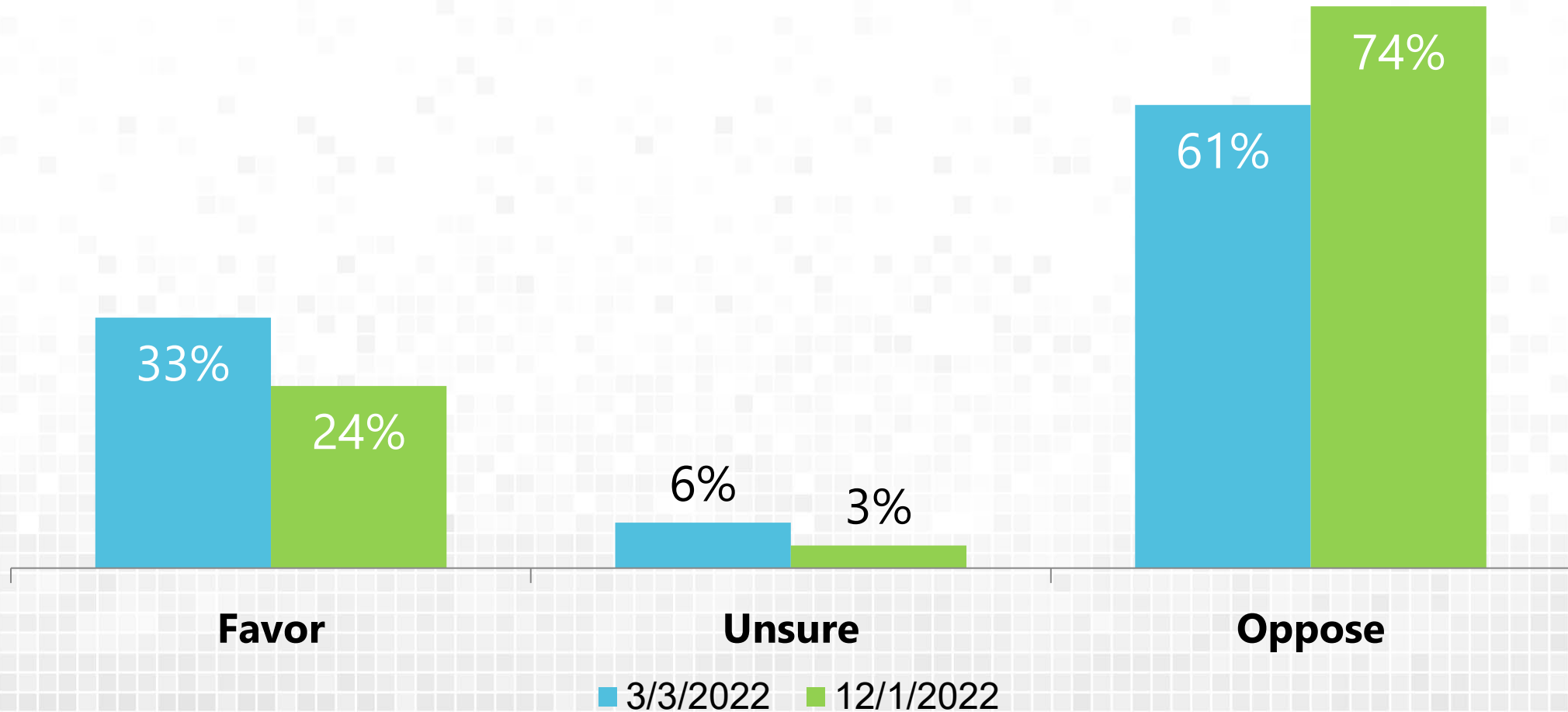

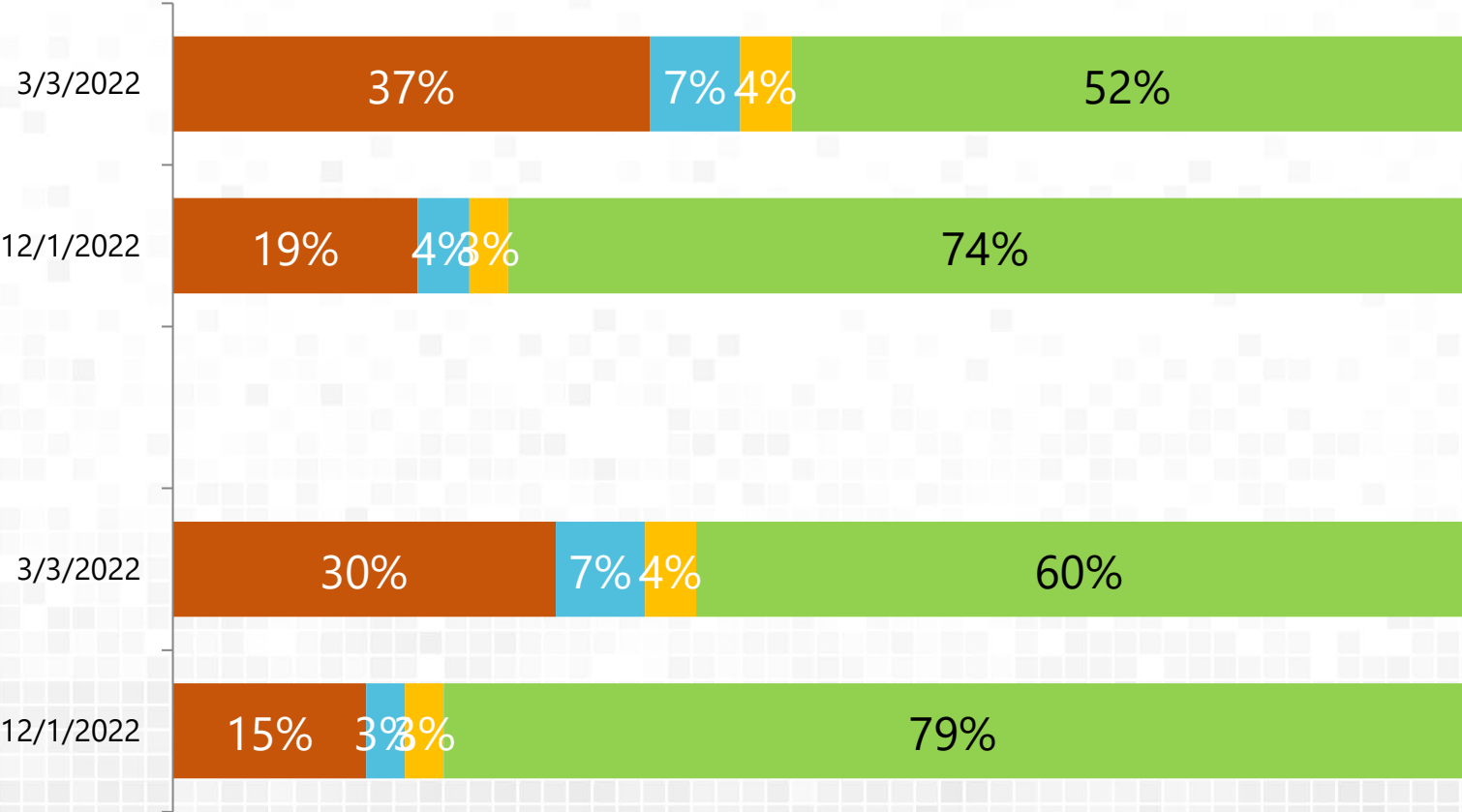

Do you favor or oppose using taxpayer dollars to fund private school tuition?

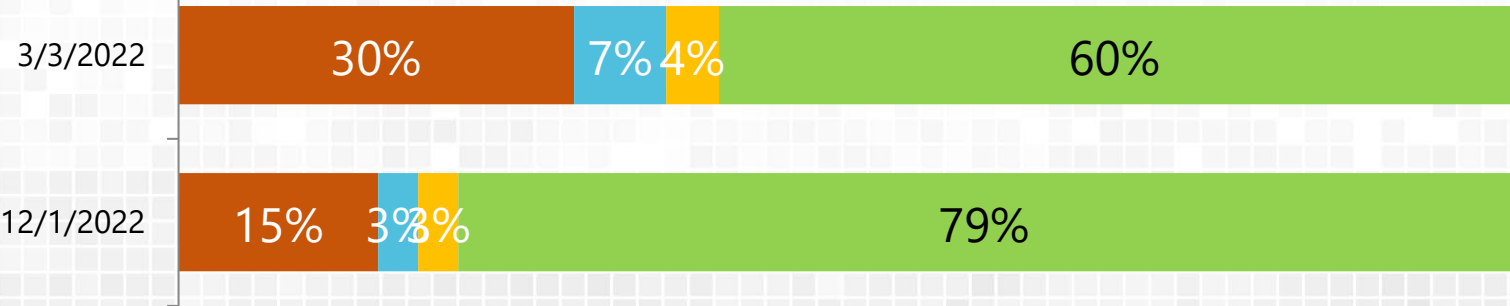

These voucher programs mean there is less money available to maintain and improve our public schools.



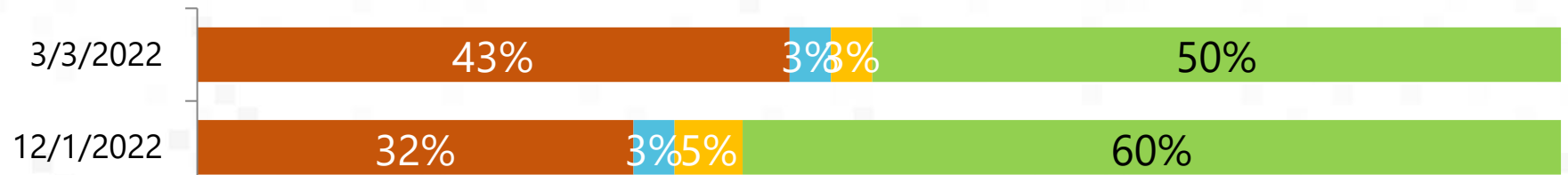
Families in rural areas with no access to private school options will be hurt by these voucher programs. Their public schools will get less funding while they are helping to pay for other children to attend private schools.

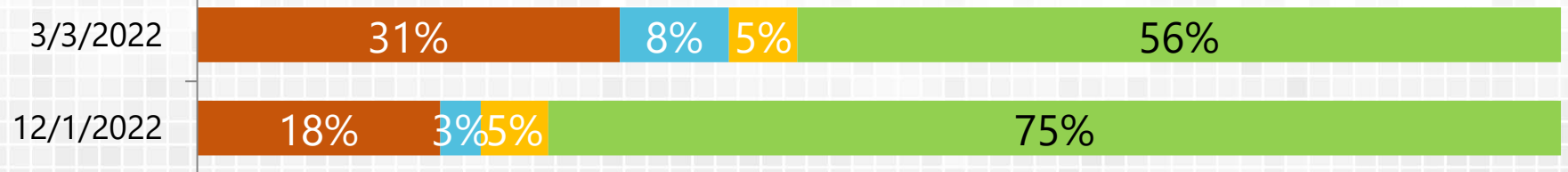
These programs are an important way to give parents choices and create competition that will improve all schools in the state.



While public schools are available in every county in the state, these vouchers can only be used in schools in about one-third of the state.

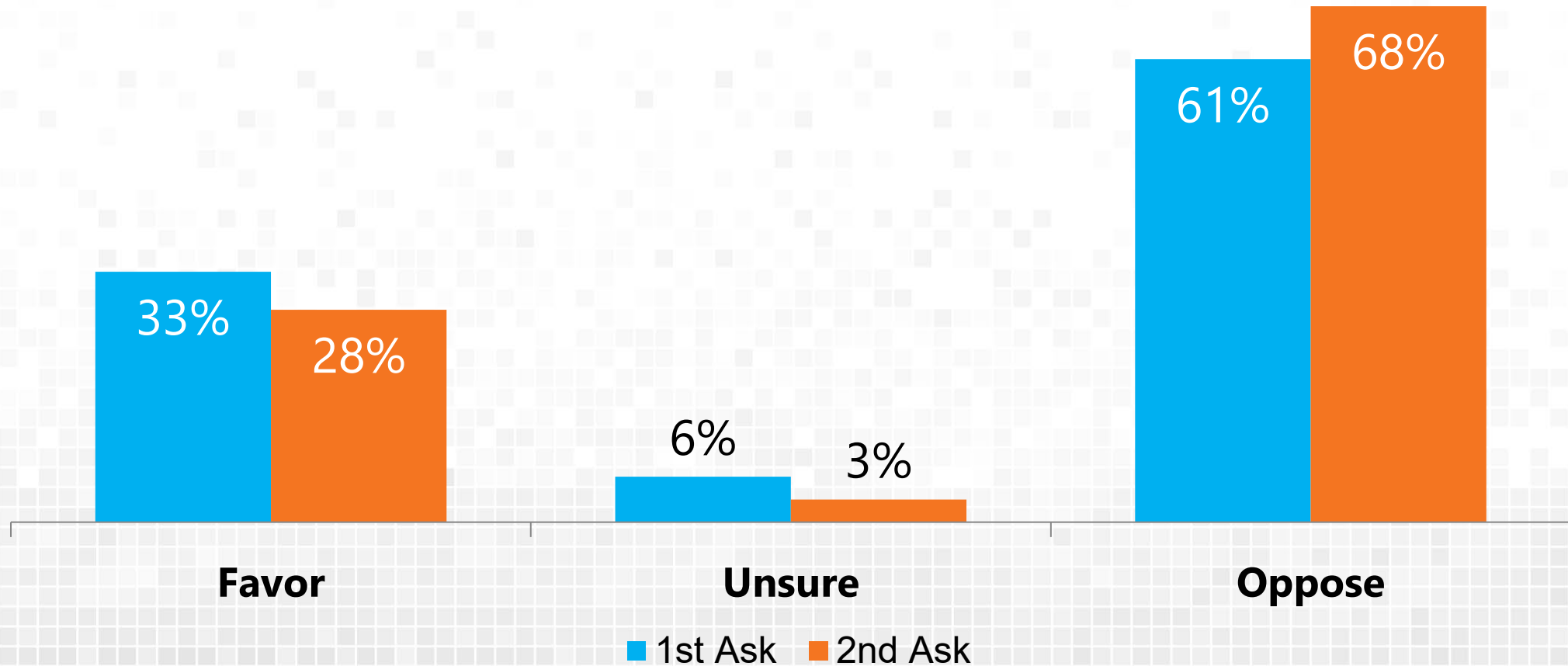


Private schools are not required to follow the student testing programs or the teacher accountability programs like Oklahoma public schools



More Likely Unsure No Difference Less Likely

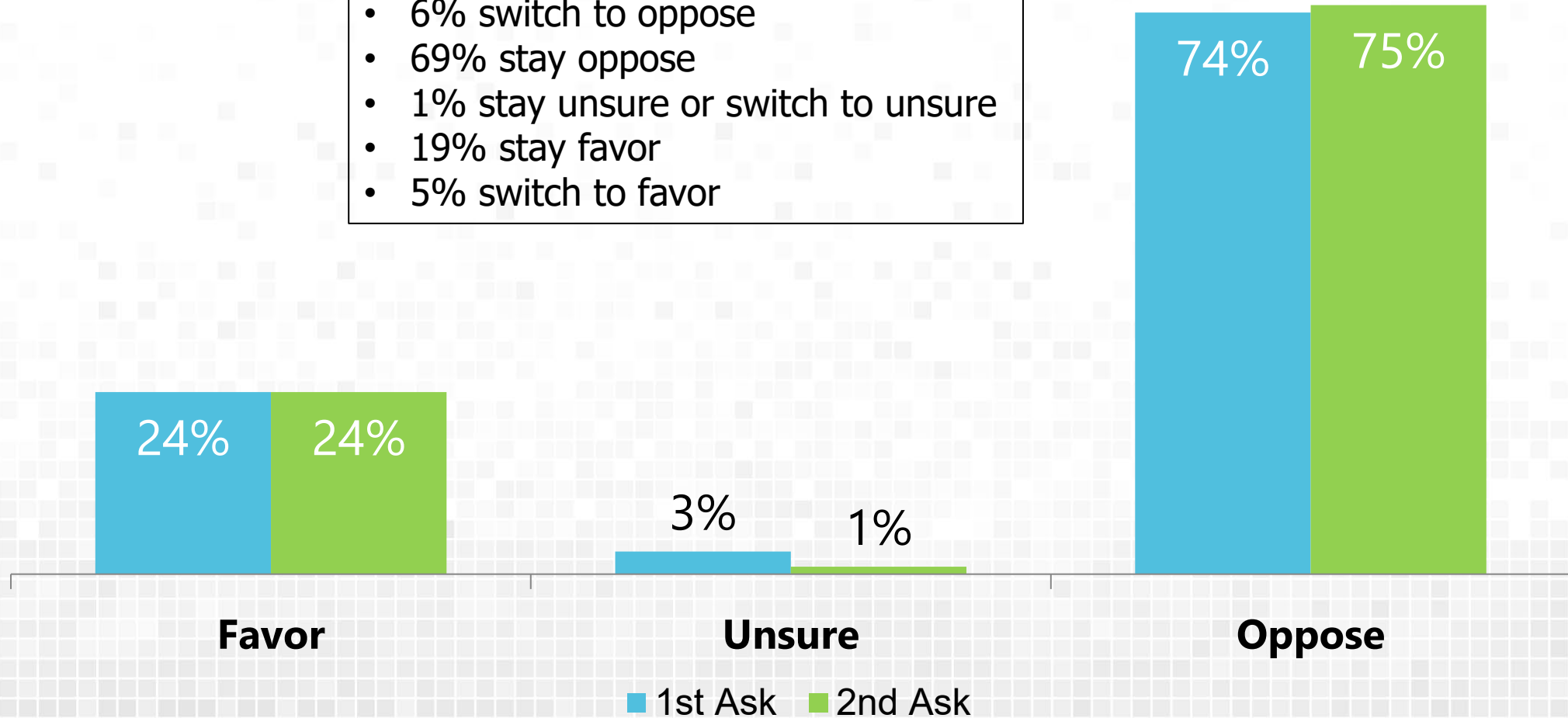
Do you favor or oppose using taxpayer dollars to fund private school tuition? March, 2022
